Special Election

The Village of Edgar will participate in the special elections needed to fill the seat of Scott Suder who is resigning. After the most recent redistricting, the entire Village is now in the 69th Assembly district. The primary will be held on Tuesday, October 22nd and the general election will be Tuesday, November 19th at the Village Hall from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm as usual.

Community Update Info

Fall Clean-up - Please do not rake leaves into the street as this is prohibited by the Village. The leaves may wash into the storm sewer, clogging inlets and sewer pipes. In addition, the amount of leaves will make its way to streams and rivers creating an increased organic matter in the environment. The Village ask you place leaves, grass, etc. in clear 30-gallon size bags on the scheduled September 24th and October 22nd collection days. Feeling energetic, you can place your leaves on the Yard Waste pile in the Industrial Park for disposal anytime.

Fall Tree Trimming - The best time to prune a tree or bush is when it goes dormant, which is late fall to early spring. When the tree or bush is not active, the removal of limbs will be less stressful. An additional day in November has been added for this reason. Place cut ends toward the street and please bundle the brush with string. We allow 5 minutes per household. If the workers go over this time frame the resident will be charged the additional time. The scheduled days are October 8th & November 5th.

No Overnight Parking - From November 1 to April 1, parking is prohibited on streets and alleys between the hours of 3:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M.

Garage Sale Signs - It must be frustrating for bargain hunters to see a yard sale sign, start driving and you don't see any evidence of a sale. Flip side, it is frustrating to see these weathered signs hanging up for months around the village. The Village is perfectly fine with allowing you to hang up the signs but please remove them immediately after the sale. If village employees need to remove a sale sign we will be invoicing that address \$25 per sign removal. Let's show we are proud of Edgar's appearance!

Fire Prevention Week - October 6 - 12, 2013 Per a 2010 survey about 75% of all U.S. homes have at least *one working* smoke alarm. Almost 66% of home fire *deaths* from 2005-2009 resulted from **NO** working smoke alarm. **Check your batteries to make sure they are not missing, disconnected or dead. The lifetime of smoke detectors are 10 years due to dust and dirt accumulation within. Don't be caught dead wrong please**
