Call to Order – Roll Call: The License/Building/Safety/Zoning Committee was called to order by Chairperson Lepak at 7:05 pm. Members Butt, Huebsch, Maurer, and Werner also present. Quorum.

Approve Agenda: Motion by Schilling/Maurer to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Variance Request: Motion by Lepak/Huebsch to approve the variance request by Allan Heil for property located at 1401 S. 3rd Avenue to build a 30 foot by 60 foot pole building with no more than 20 feet in height and must be 12 feet from property line. All ayes. Motion carried.
