License/Building/Safety/Zoning Committee Meeting
August 3, 2015

Call to Order – Roll Call: The License/Building/Safety/Zoning Committee was called to order by Chairperson Lepak at 6:30 pm. Members Maurer, Huebsch, Werner, and Van Der Leest also present. Quorum.

Guests: Trustees Schueller and Schilling, Police Chief Stankowski, Peter Weinschenk, Jeff Dauterman, John Daniels, Geraldine Newman, Duane Kamerick, Gary Weiland, Lowell Borchardt, Greg Stark, Frank (?) and Mrs. Randy Denfield also in attendance.

Approve Agenda: Motion by Van Der Leest/Werner to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

ATV Issues: Police Chief Stankowski outlined safety concerns of ATVs on roadways. Additional information was provided by guest speaker Jeff Dauterman, Marathon County Recreational Safety Warden. ATVs cannot be used for snowplowing nor operated in parks. During the snowmobile season, ATVs can only be used when approved snowmobile trails are open. ATVs can be operated under supervision at age 12 if safety course has been successfully completed and unsupervised at age 16 and up with a valid driver license. Other residences spoke to share their opposition to opening roadways to ATVs. Motion by Lepak/Werner to recommend keeping it status quo with the one route from a county recreational trail to the R-Store for gas. 4 ayes (Lepak, Huebsch, Werner and Van Der Leest) and 1 nay (Maurer). Motion carried.

Fire Hydrant: Motion by Van Der Leest/Werner to recommend that once the Softball Association completes the excavation of opening the water lines to the softball diamond, the Village will evaluate if insulation should go around the water lines. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Trick or Treat: Motion by Lepak/Maurer to recommend establishing official trick-or-treating hours on Saturday, October 31 from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Adjournment: Motion by Maurer/Van Der Leest to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 pm.
