## Illegal Dumping...

There have been instances of illegal dumping in the Village recycling yard recently. As a reminder, only



leaves, grass clippings, branches, and other compostable or chippable yard waste from Village residents are allowed. Other wood products such as construction materials are prohibited. Likewise, only concrete products are to be placed on the concrete pile. It is the goal of the Village to grind the concrete for use as a base for road reconstruction projects; any foreign material like metal, cinder blocks, bricks, or asphalt will decrease the quality of the material that we will use for our streets in the future. Call Veolia Environmental Services at 715-359-6637 if you require a dumpster to be dropped off at your residence.

## Tornado & Severe Weather Awareness Week ...

A Tornado Drill is scheduled for Thursday, April 19. Sirens will sound

for 3 minutes at 1:45 pm.. If actual severe weather occurs, this will be postponed until Friday, April 20th.

## \$1400 vs 50 cents...

...is the cost of drinking the recommended eight glasses of water per day for one year of Bottled water vs Tap water

1. City water must be tested by government certified labs. Bottled water companies have no such requirements.
2. Municipal tap water must be tested for coliform bacteria.
3. Tap water is not permitted to contain E-coli or fecal coliform bacteria. This same requirement is not included in the FDA guidelines for bottled water.

Pour yourself a glass of TAP water!

## Veolia Garbage Container Count ....

Our garbage collection and recycling contractor, Veolia Environmental Services, has notified us that there are several residences that have more than one wheeled garbage container and that, even if they are not at the curb, the Village is being billed

for each container. The Village asks for your assistance in obtaining an accurate count of the Veolia-owned containers so that we can keep our rates as low as possible. (This also includes wheeled containers of any size that say Superior or Onyx.) During the month of April, please call us at the Village Hall if you have more than one container per

residence. We will then schedule with Veolia and with you a time to have your extras picked up. Those residences that have or need multiple containers will be charged accordingly on the next quarterly water bill in July.
