- ◆ Assessor must be allowed to examine property.
- ◆ Owner must be present, no phone calls allowed.
- ◆ In writing, specify the owner's estimate of the value of the land and improvements that are the subject of the objection and specify the information used to arrive at that estimate.
- ◆ Contact Administrator Eric Rindfleisch, at least 48 hours before Board of Review

Clean Up America Recyclers - Sat. April 27th, 2013

Bring your items to the gate of the Village Yard located on Thomas Hill Rd between 9:00 am—12:00 pm.

Free of charge items include but not limited to: bikes, batteries, freezers, microwaves, refrigerators, dish washers, water heaters, washer/dryers, lawn movers, exercise equipment, bath tubs, gas & charcoal grills, copiers, printers, computer components. Televisions and computer monitors will have a fee of \$5.00 and upward depending on weight.

Doggy Doo-doo - Out of respect for your neighbors please be courteous and pick up after your dog after it does its "doo-ty". Let's be proud of Edgar and keep the village a clean and safe environment for visitors and residents.

Village recycling yard - As a reminder with Spring clean-up on our mind only leaves, grass clippings, branches, and other chippable yard waste (no stumps) from Village residents are allowed. Only concrete, asphalt & brick on concrete pile. If you require a large dumpster for construction or home improvement waste call Advanced Deposal at 715-359-6637.

Spring clean-up in your cupboards - If you have found that you have several unused cans of food sitting in your cupboard, consider donating them to the area Circle of Joy. Food may be dropped off at the Village Office between the hours of 8:30 to 4:30 Monday thru Friday.

The Village of Edgar prohibits back yard burning of waste material such as plywood and cardboard. Recreational campfires are allowed. Firewood should be less than 20" in diameter and at no time should a fire be left unattended. Marshmallows are allowed!

Utility Billing ... The Village of Edgar now accepts credit and debit card payments on our website www.vil.edgar.wi.us through GovPayNet. Payments can be made for a utility bill, a tax payment or a Village invoice with a major credit, debit or prepaid debit card. If necessary, you may also call GovPayNet 24 hours a day at 1-(888) 604-7888. You may also make payments at the Village Hall using cash, credit/debit cards, and checks. Of course, you are still able to mail your payment to us at no charge - except for the stamp. Please note, payments processed through GovPayNet online or telephone systems include an additional service fee; the Village of Edgar does not collect this; the fee allows for the convenience of using a credit or debit card.
