**Spring Cleaning: A Complete Checklist** - Flowers will be blooming, birds are serenading and our homes and yards are stuck in the winter blues. The Village has put together a list of helpful dates and opportunities to welcome "Spring".



### Clean Up America - Saturday, April 26th, 2014

Between the hours of 9:00 am - 12:00 pm, you are welcome to bring your items to a waiting truck located at the Village yard gate located on Thomas Hill Rd. A full description of items can be found on the Village website in regards to what Darrell will take "free of charge". A small fee will be charged for televisions and computer monitors; otherwise Best Buy will take small televisions and computers for free.



**Village Recycling Yard** - Only leaves, grass clippings, branches, and other chippable yard waste (no stumps) from Village residents are allowed. Please only concrete, asphalt and brick are permitted on the concrete pile.



**Yard Waste Curbside Collection** - Every other Tuesday beginning May 6th, 2014, the Village crew will be picking up no larger than 30 gallon clear bags of Yard Waste, only leaves and grass allowed. Curbside Chipping begins May 20th, 2014. Bundle brush w/string and anytime in excess of 5 minutes will be billed to resident.

### Open Burn Permits and campfires ..

The appeal of a back yard camp fire is timeless and relaxing for family and friends. It can also be uncomfortable for your neighbors regarding the smoke; do show neighborliness towards others. The material burned must be clean wood; fire pits are not to be used to burn trash, construction material or green wood. Wood should be less than 20" in diameter and NEVER leave it unattended. A water hose, fire extinguisher or sand should

be near for an emergency and extinguish the fire completely before leaving the area. Enjoy a fun evening with hot dogs to Smores roasting over the fire but be safe around the fire.
