Community Update Info

Utility Billing Summer-Credit - With summer and warmer temperatures comes residential summer sewer credit? You will notice on the utility bills for the next two quarters the Village will be pro-rating sewer consumption and will be reflected on the next two quarters. The credit is obtained by taking the sewer usage from the 4th quarter, 2012 and the first quarter, 2013 and divide by 2 for the average. On the next two quarters, if you go over this average, you will not be charged for sewer that appears above this summer credit average.



Utility payments - Utility bills can be paid using a debit or credit card on the Village website www.vil.edgar.wi.us using the "Payments" tab on the upper right. There is a convenience fee to use this service. To pay by check, please mail your payment to the Village Hall or drop it off during our open hours: Monday through Friday 8:15 am to Noon and 1:00 pm to 4:45 pm. Cash is also accepted at the Village Hall customer services counter.

Landlords/tenants - Whether you are moving in or out, landlords and/or tenants, please contact the Village Hall immediately. We will read the meter as close to the move in/out day to obtain an accurate pro-rated final utility bill. This is also the small window landlords have in which to deduct any out-standing bills owed by the tenant.

Doggie Doo-doo - Not everyone may feel the same way you do as a pet owner. It is your responsibility to have your pet under your direct control at all times. If your pet is off your property, it needs to be leashed to prevent the animal from going onto someone else's property even for a brief moment. Please, also pick up after your dog's feces, bagging it and disposing of it properly; it is a Village ordinance.

Recreational Fires ...

Any fire such as a campfire or cooking fire used



for the purpose of recreation and personal enjoyment are permitted but cannot involve the burning of yard or building waste.

The following rules must be followed: fire takes place in a fire pit no larger than 24" in diameter. Someone must be present at the fire site at all times, and the fire

must be totally extinguished before leaving the area. Please remember, **BURN BARRELS** are prohibited in the Village.

Grass clippings and leaves should be bagged and disposed at the "Yard Waste" sign at the Recycling Center located in the Business Park. The Village crew will also pick up and dispose on the scheduled days of July 16th & 30th, August 27th, and September 24th if placed at your property line.

We Goofed ... 2013 Garbage, Recycling Calendar If you have not received the "REVISED" garbage calendar for 2013, they are available upon request, can be downloaded off the website, or available at the Village Office.

Garbage dumpsters ... No you are not going to find the missing dumpster wheel inside. You may be one of many where the dumpster is returned back to your yard with broken wheels, etc. Advanced Disposal



asked if you would please park your full garbage cart at the end of your driveway to one side. The automatic arm is designed for grabbing carts at this level when grabbing down by the wheel area. If your cart happens to be dismembered or crushed please call the Village Hall for replacements. Advance Disposal would prefer this method of reporting broken garbage carts. Place the damaged cart out at the end of your driveway until Advanced can

exchange it out...usually within 5-7 business days. You can continue to discard garbage in these carts.

Advance Disposal no longer replaces recycling bins. This practice of supplying bins for sorting out recyclables ended a few years back. You may use any open bin of your choosing or place in clear plastic bags on recycling day.

Hydrant Flushing ... July 15-19th, 2013

Flushing removes sediments that may affect the water's taste and color and is an essential preventive maintenance strategy for the water distribution system.

Flushing may cause your water to appear cloudy or discolored. Though not harmful, avoid doing white laundry day of flushing.

If this occurs:

- 1) Wait until the nearby flushing is complete
- 2) Remove faucet aerators or filters
- 3) Let the COLD water faucet run until the water clears
- 4) Replace faucet aerators or filters
