Tax Payment Deadlines

Full payment of taxes: Due by January 31, 2014 payable to Village of Edgar.
By installments: First installment is due on or before January 31, 2014 to the Village of Edgar. Second installment due July 31, 2014 to Marathon County Treasurer. **Lottery Credit:** If you occupied your home as your primary residence on January 1, 2013, your tax bill should include the lottery credit. Please check your tax bill to ensure you are receiving this reduction in taxes. If credit has been omitted, please bring your tax bill to the Village Office for an instant correction up to January 31, 2014.

Snow and Ice removal: - For safety reasons all sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice on your lot or parcel within 24 hours after the snowfall ends. Sprinkle with sand and/or salt to provide a safe walking environment. A black bin located outside the Thomas Hill garage fence contains a sand/salt mixture for

homeowners only for usage on sidewalks. It is in violation not to clean sidewalks and prohibited to push snow into or across the streets. Fines may be imposed for those in violation.

No Overnight Parking - From November 1 to April 1, parking is prohibited on streets and alleys. No overnight parking is allowed unless authorization is issued by the Police Dept. If non-compliance, a parking ticket will be issued immediately.

Cat & Dog Licensing:



Many residents wonder why license my pet? The Village is reminded of a stray dog who wandered into town. Thanks to the dog tag he was wearing the Humane Society was able to safely return him to his owners in Hatley.

The dog and cat license fee must be renewed annually by March 31st, 2014. A rabies vaccination certificate must be turned in at time of registration. These fees are an important funding source for the Marathon County Humane Society operations and returning your pet back to you.

Water and Sewer Line Breaks - Cold weather and water lines can create some unpleasant breakages this time of the year. If you notice low or no water pressure, please call one of the Public Works cell numbers immediately. Cells numbers can be located in the upper left-hand side of this page.

- 1) Remember to keep sidewalks clean.
- 2) No Overnight Parking on streets in effect until April 1, 2014
- 3) Remove garbage dumpers after pick-up back into your yard.
- 4) Adopt a fire hydrant for the winter.
