If you wish to dispute your assessed value, the following criteria must be met: Assessor must be allowed to examine property; owner must be present at the meeting; no phone calls allowed; owner must have written explanation of their estimate of the value of the land & any improvements to it regarding their objection with additional information specifying how they came to their estimate; & contact the Administrator, Jennifer Lopez, at least 48 hours before the Board of Review.

**Thomas Hill Road Reconstruction...** Bids for the Thomas Hill Road reconstruction will be opened on April 10<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 PM at the Village Hall. The project comprises reconstructing Thomas Hill Rd between CTH H/S. 3rd Ave and S. 1st Ave. The project also includes reconstructing S. 1st Ave between Thomas Hill Rd and the southern end of the road. The proposed roadway improvements include asphaltic pavement removal, excavation and grading, concrete curb and gutter removal and replacement, concrete sidewalk removal and replacement, driveway approach removal and replacement. prescription medications, while also educating the general public about the potential abuse of these medications. Unused prescription medications in homes create a public health and safety concern because they can be accidentally ingested, stolen, misused and abused. Unused or expired medicine should never be flushed or poured down the drain. Removing potentially dangerous pharmaceutical substances from our state's medicine cabinets helps to prevent them from going into our water supply. Water reclamation facilities are not designed to remove all of them and trace amounts of pharmaceuticals are showing up in our rivers and lakes. **ALL WASTE PHARMACEUTICALS MUST BE GENERATED BY A HOUSEHOLD. NO BUSINESSES ALLOWED. Items ALLOWED include:** Prescription (controlled and non-controlled) and over-the-counter medications, ointments, patches, non-aerosol sprays, inhalers, creams, vials and pet medications. **Items NOT ALLOWED are:** Illegal drugs, needles/sharps, aerosol cans, bio-hazardous materials (anything containing a bodily fluid or blood), mercury thermometers, personal care products (shampoo, soaps, lotions, sunscreens, etc.), household hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas).
