

**Simple Steps for Bicycle Safety**

Bicycling is a fun and healthy way to get around and get your daily dose of physical activity. Before riding, make sure you and your bike are ready to ride.

1. WEAR A HELMET. Make sure it fits and is strapped on.
2. FOLLOW THE RULES OF THE ROAD. Stop at stop signs. Ride to the right when on the road, with the flow of traffic. Walk your bike across busy intersections.
3. SIGNAL YOUR MOVES.
4. CHECK YOUR GEAR. Make sure your tires have air, brakes work, seat adjusted and nothing seems loose.
5. SEE AND BE SEEN. Wear bright and/or reflective clothing and always use lights when riding at night.
6. LOOK FOR HAZARDS. Look ahead for cars pulling out of driveways or people exiting parked cars. Always look both ways and scan ahead when turning.
