Bags of Yard Waste Collected*

Note: *Leaves, grass, etc., in clear 30 gallon bags - NO TREES OR STUMPS

*Full Bags cannot weigh more than 50 lbs or they will be left curbside

During Yard Waste & Curbside Pickup, we ask that you:

Place cut ends toward street. Bundle brush with string.

No pile greater than 4 ft long and 4 ft high will be picked up.

HAUL YOUR OWN YARDWASTE TO THE VILLAGE SITE (NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS):

Bags MUST be dumped on the pile by the "Yard Waste" sign .

Empty, used bags can be placed in waste containers for disposal

xx Read Meters (xx= around the 15th of the month, where applicable)

Utility Bill Due - 21st day of January, April, July, & October

Spring/ Fall Clean Up Day - tentative

Dear Valued Customer

- Please have material curbside before 6:00 am.
- All garbage must be placed in plastic bags (white or clear) and securely tied shut. Absolutely no loose garbage in containers.
- Please call our office for pricing and to schedule a bulky item pickup. (Electronics, Appliances, Tires, Furniture, Etc.) This is every other Wednesday
- Cart is facing the wrong direction. (Wheels and Handle should face the house.)
- Place cart a minimum of (4) feet from any obstacle, including other carts.
- All bagged household garbage should be placed in cart with lid fully closed.
- Excessive cart/can weight (limit 50 pounds each).
- Trash and/or recyclables must be separated.
- Unacceptable items were left behind (Ex: Asbestos, Building demo (ex. carpet, drywall, insulation, wood), Empty chemical containers, Liquid waste, Used Motor Oil, Hazardous waste, Yard waste and/or Other Non-Household Trash).
- Cardboard must be cut, bundled and tied in sections no larger than 2 feet by 2 feet.
- No barrels or drums.
- Additional carts available to rent. Please call office for details.

RECYCLING GUIDE

PLASTIC:

ACCEPT

- Only #1 & #2 Plastic Bottles & Containers:
Soda, Water, & Other Drink Bottles
- Food & Household Bottles, Jars and Jugs
- Dairy Containers & Lids
- Produce, Bakery & Deli Containers

DO NOT ACCEPT

- No Plastic Bags, Wrap or Film
- No Motor Oil Bottles
- No Styrofoam

GUIDELINES:

Empty and rinse all bottles and containers
Remove and discard all screw caps

PAPER:

ACCEPT

- Newspapers & Insert
- Cardboard & Paperboard
- Junk Mail & Office Paper
- Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons
- Phonebooks, Books, Magazines & Catalogs

DO NOT ACCEPT

- No Paper Contaminated by:
Food or Grease
- No Tissue
- No Gift Wrap
- No Shredded Paper



GUIDELINES:

Flatten and cut cardboard to no larger than 2' x 2'

METAL AND GLASS:

ACCEPT

- Aluminum Bottles & Cans
- Steel, Tin & Bi-metal Cans
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Food & Beverage Bottles and Jars

DO NOT ACCEPT

- No Aluminum Pans or Foil
- No Empty Paint Cans

GUIDELINES:

Empty and rinse all bottles and containers
Remove and discard all screw caps
