

May 13, 2024, Construction update!

Please note that the Village garage sales are this week. During this time, there will be construction; however, the contractors will do their best to allow safe passage around the construction areas.

South Section of Hwy H/3rd Avenue:

The manhole at the intersection of Hwy H/3rd Avenue and Quaw Avenue has been completed.

There's been a slight change to the detour route. Traffic will now be diverted off Hwy H/3rd Avenue onto Brooklyn Avenue, then down Gumaer Street, and finally onto Royal Avenue. This detour is necessary for the installation of new sanitary sewer. Local traffic will still have access around the barricades for much of the project.

During the detour, the affected area will be designated as no street parking. Garbage collection on Hwy H/3rd Avenue will continue as normal; our crews will relocate your containers as needed. Additionally, please retrieve your mail from the post office during construction.

Birch Street:

Construction is ongoing on Birch Street, and preparations have been made for new curb and gutter (east side) as well as asphalt on First Avenue. Garbage collection on Birch Street will continue as normal; our crews will relocate your containers as needed.

Thomas Hill Road

The project has commenced, and garbage collection on Hwy Thomas Hill can continue as normal; our crews will relocate your containers as needed. Starting tomorrow, we kindly request that everyone with mailboxes on Thomas Hill Road retrieve their mail from the Post Office.

Please remember that Village regulations on driveway width have increased to a maximum of 30' at the opening. A driveway permit is required for all updated driveways; there is no cost for the permit if you are in the project area.
