

May 17, 2024, Construction update!

South Section of Hwy H/3rd Avenue:

The construction work on the road is now complete, and American Asphalt is expected to shape and pave the road early next week, weather permitting. The detour will end once the paving is complete.

Birch Street:

The construction work on the road is now complete, and American Asphalt is expected to shape and pave the road early next week, weather permitting. The detour will end once the paving is complete.

Thomas Hill Road

The project is in full swing. Two water hydrants will be replaced on Wednesday next week, which may cause temporary interruptions in water service.

Earth Inc. is working on the relocation of the lift station and the operation of the new lift station near the intersection of Wisconsin Avenue, while Switlick and Sons is working on the road and sewer main replacement. Garbage collection on Thomas Hill Road will continue as normal; our crews will relocate your containers as needed. Residents with mailboxes on Thomas Hill Road will continue to retrieve their mail from the Post Office.

Wisconsin Avenue/George Wagner Drive

There will be water valve replacements on Tuesday and Wednesday next week, which may cause temporary interruptions in water service. Additionally, the asphalt on Wisconsin Avenue and George Wagner Drive may be removed next week, schedule permitting. Garbage collection on Wisconsin Avenue and George Wagner Drive will continue as normal; our crews will relocate your containers as needed. Residents with mailboxes along the route will eventually be asked to retrieve their mail from the Post Office, you will receive a postcard from the mail carrier with additional details.

Please remember that Village regulations on driveway width have increased to a maximum of 30' at the opening. A driveway permit is required for all updated driveways; there is no cost for the permit if you are in the project area.
