

May 24th, 2024, Construction update!

South Section of Hwy H/3rd Avenue and Birch Street:

Rent A Flash will be picking up the barricades and the road project will be fully open. Construction is complete! We will no longer be enforcing the no parking on the street along the 3rd Avenue detour route; thank you for your patience. Birch Street - Your mailboxes should be reinstalled permanently next week.

Thomas Hill Road

Thank you for your patience as the valves were repaired and the hydrants were installed. We do not anticipate additional interruptions in the water service. Storm sewer will be installed next week.

Earth Inc. is working on the relocation of the lift station and the operation of the new lift station near the intersection of Wisconsin Avenue, while Switlick and Sons is working on the road and sewer main replacement. Garbage collection on Thomas Hill Road will continue as normal; our crews will relocate your containers as needed. Residents with mailboxes on Thomas Hill Road will continue to retrieve their mail from the Post Office.

Wisconsin Avenue/George Wagner Drive

Temporary water is being installed. Before the changeover, the Village needs to receive two safe water samples. During this period, residents will not be charged for water or sewer consumption. Garbage collection on Wisconsin Avenue and George Wagner Drive will continue as normal. Our crews will relocate your containers as needed. Residents with mailboxes along the route will eventually need to retrieve their mail from the Post Office. You will receive a postcard from the mail carrier with additional details.

Storm Damage

Brush/limbs can continue to be taken to the brush pile off East Limits Road. The next regularly scheduled yard waste/brush pick up will be on June 4th. We do not accept stumps or logs.



Bags of Yard Waste Collected*

Note: *Leaves, grass, etc., in clear 30 gallon bags

*Full Bags cannot weigh more than 50 lbs or they will be left curbside

During Yard Waste & Curbside Pickup, we ask that you:

Place cut ends toward street. Bundle brush with string.

No pile greater than 4 ft long and 4 ft high will be picked up.

HAUL YOUR OWN YARDWASTE TO THE VILLAGE SITE (NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS):

Bags MUST be dumped on the pile by the "Yard Waste" sign .

Empty, used bags can be placed in waste containers for disposal

To assist us in estimating village-wide residential and commercial damages, please email storm@edgarwi.gov with the following information:

- Whether the property is residential or commercial

This information will help us with filing for any disaster relief efforts that may become available.
