

## May 31st, 2024, Construction update!

### Birch Street:

Weather permitting, American Asphalt will lay the final layer of asphalt during the week of June 10th.

### Thomas Hill Road

S.D. Ellenbecker is expected to be in town next week to start the concrete work. During this time, please park on the road. It is advised to allow the concrete to cure for one week after placement. Garbage collection on Thomas Hill Road will continue as usual, and our crews will move your containers as needed. Residents with mailboxes on Thomas Hill Road should continue to pick up their mail from the Post Office.

### Wisconsin Avenue/George Wagner Drive

Starting Monday and continuing through the week, we will begin switching to temporary water on Wisconsin Avenue. We will proceed to the east side once the final safe water test is received. During this time, residents will not be billed for water or sewer usage. Garbage collection on Wisconsin Avenue and George Wagner Drive will proceed as usual, and our crews will move your containers as necessary. Residents with mailboxes along the route should continue to pick up their mail from the Post Office.

### Storm Damage

Brush/limbs can continue to be taken to the brush pile off East Limits Road. The next regularly scheduled yard waste/brush pick up will be on June 4<sup>th</sup>. We do not accept stumps or logs.



Bags of Yard Waste Collected\*

Note: \*Leaves, grass, etc., in clear 30 gallon bags

\*Full Bags cannot weigh more than 50 lbs or they will be left curbside

During Yard Waste & Curbside Pickup, we ask that you:

Place cut ends toward street. Bundle brush with string.

No pile greater than 4 ft long and 4 ft high will be picked up.

**HAUL YOUR OWN *YARDWASTE* TO THE VILLAGE SITE ( *NO* CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS):**

Bags MUST be dumped on the pile by the "Yard Waste" sign .

Empty, used bags can be placed in waste containers for disposal
