

May 7, 2024, Construction update!

Please note that the Village garage sales are scheduled for May 16th, 17th, and 18th, 2024. During this time, there will be construction; however, the contractors will do their best to allow safe passage around the construction areas.

South Section of Hwy H/3rd Avenue:

Please be informed that the manhole on the intersection of Hwy H/3rd Avenue and Quaw Avenue will undergo replacement this week on Thursday. To ensure safety during the installation, traffic will be directed by flagmen and Hwy H/3rd Avenue will remain open.

Additionally, starting on Friday, a detour will be in effect for the project site located between Quaw Avenue and Clear View Court. The detour route will divert traffic off Hwy H/3rd Avenue onto Quaw Avenue, then onto Gumaer Street, and finally down to Royal Avenue. This detour is necessary to facilitate the installation of new sanitary sewer. Local traffic will be able to maneuver around the barricades through much of the project.

During the detour period, the affected area will be posted for no street parking. Garbage collection on Hwy H/3rd Avenue can proceed as usual; our crews will relocate your containers as necessary. Furthermore, please pick up your mail at the post office during the duration of construction.

Birch Street:

Construction is continuing on Birch Street, and First Avenue has been prepared for new curb and gutter (east side) as well as asphalt. Garbage collection on Birch Street can proceed as usual; our crews will relocate your containers as necessary.

Thomas Hill Road

While the project will officially start later, the asphalt will be removed starting mid-week. Garbage collection on Monday will remain unchanged, and we will keep you informed about the plan for temporary mailboxes as it develops.

Please remember that Village regulations on driveway width have increased to a maximum of 30' at the opening. A driveway permit is required for all updated driveways; there is no cost for the permit if you are in the project area.
