

June 21, 2024, Construction update!

Birch Street:

Weather permitting, American Asphalt will lay the final layer of asphalt during the week of June 24th.

Thomas Hill Road

S.D. Ellenbecker has completed the sidewalks and driveway approaches. To reduce congestion on Thomas Hill Road, please utilize side streets for parking when possible.

When parking on First Avenue, kindly park as far onto the grass shoulder as possible to allow residential traffic to maneuver safely.

Please note that it is advised to allow the concrete to cure for one week after placement. Garbage collection on Thomas Hill Road will continue as usual.

Wisconsin Avenue/George Wagner Drive

Due to wet weather, travel in this area has become difficult. The contractor is working diligently to keep the road passable, but each additional rain event complicates this effort. Garbage collection on Wisconsin Avenue and George Wagner Drive will continue as usual. Our crews will ensure your containers are moved as necessary to facilitate this process.

Please be aware that the road crew has encountered unsuitable soil, which may require additional replacement of the road base to ensure a high-quality final product. Consequently, the drying of these soils may cause a delay in the asphalt paving.

Residents with mailboxes along the route should continue to pick up their mail from the Post Office until further notice.

2025 Hwy H Project

Residents along Highway H may have noticed staves with pink marks in their yards. If you have these staves, you should have received a letter from Cheryl Schroeder of Becher Hoppe on May 1, 2024. The Village of Edgar has hired Becher Hoppe to help obtain temporary easements for ADA-compliant sidewalk curb ramps.

Explanation of Staking: The survey crew has staked the proposed new right-of-way limits, which are primarily Temporary Limited Easements (TLEs). These stakes will help you and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) understand the easement locations and assist in property assessments.

Residents were asked to return an "Ownership Information Sheet." If you haven't done so, please return it promptly.

It is crucial that this process proceeds smoothly to avoid project delays. Any delays could result in the project being postponed by at least two years, potentially leading to a loss of grant funding and increased costs. The project is currently scheduled to begin in Spring 2025. If you did not receive the letter, or misplaced it, please contact Village Hall and we can assist you.
