Call to Order – Roll Call: The License/Building/Safety/Zoning Committee was called to order by Chairperson Butt at 7:00 pm. Members Lepak, Streit, Schroeder Schuett and Werner were present.

Approve Agenda: Motion by Werner/Lepak to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Chalk Fest parking lot/alley closure: Motion Streit/Schroeder Schuett to recommend to the Village Board the closure of the Village Hall parking lot and alley for Chalk Fest. It was stated that the Car Show will again take place on the Szmanda parking lot. All ayes. Motion carried.

2018-2019 Operator License: Motion Lepak/Werner to recommend to the Village Board the approval of an operator license for Tiffany Burke (Edgar IGA #2018-59). All ayes. Motion carried.

Departmental update from Police Chief Stankowski: Chief Stankowski informed the Board that the front computer is now set up with Windows 10. The Toughbook is also set up, but is working out issues with the Arbitrator program. The Village has now been set up for First Net; this allows the Village Cell Phones to have first priority of cell tower service in an emergency. The Police Department will give a presentation to the Edgar High School Students on impaired driving prior to the Edgar Prom. Interviews for the part-time Police Officer position will be held for six applicants next Thursday evening.
