Grant Authority to the Village Administrator to grant Temporary Class B/"Class B" Retailer License (Picnic Licenses): Motion Streit/Werner to recommend to the Village Board granting the authority to the Village Administrator to issue Temporary Class B/"Class B" Retailer's Licenses (Picnic Licenses). All ayes. Motion carried.

Hire of Eric Acosta as a Part-Time Police Officer: Motion Lepak/Werner to recommend to the Village Board to hire Eric Acosta as a Part Time Police Officer at an hourly rate of \$13/hour. All ayes. Motion carried.

Department update from Police Chief Stankowski: Chief Stankowski stated that the Department was successful in obtaining the winter Drive Sober grant in the amount of \$4,000. The Bike Rodeo was a success; 70 kids participated in the course and 80 helmets were issued. Donations allowed for books to be donated to the local First Graders. Streit questioned who participated in the interview process. It was stated that the participants were the Chief of Police, a part-time Edgar Officer, the Police Chief from the City of Stanley, and the Chief of the City of Kronenwetter. It was stated that in the future, the Board would like to require a member from the Village Board and the Administrator participate.
