Call to Order – Roll Call: The committee meeting was called to order by Chairperson Mueller at 6:33 p.m. Members present in person: VanDerLeest, Bauman, Schueller, Denfeld, Kralcik, and Lepak; Absent: Schroeder, Schroeder-Schuett, and Guenther

Guests: Administrator Lopez

Approve Agenda: Motion by Schueller/Denfeld to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Handrails – Edgar Ball Park Complex: Motion Schueller/Denfeld to approve having Streveler Fab. & Machine, Inc. build the handrails in the amount of \$7,570 at the Edgar Ball Park Complex, with having Rick Mueller pick up the rails and install them. All ayes. Motion carried. The rails have been ordered for the stairs and ramp and the goal is to have them installed by the July 19th tournament.

Tour of Parks:

Oak Street Park: It was agreed to hire a contractor to paint the ceiling of the large pavilion, once quotes are received, we will share the information with the Lions Club as they may share in the costs. The Lions have ordered a curtain for the east side of the pavilion. There are some spindles on the Tree House that need replacing. It was suggested to place drain tile on the east side of the south walkway in the park to eliminate some water.

Log cabin: The insurance adjuster inspected the roof from the storm damage; we anticipate he will suggest a full roof replacement due to the various punctures from the storm.

Minnow Ponds: Van Ert will be improving the power at the shelter (adding outlets and a breaker box in the shelter); The Minnow Pond walkway decking will be updated to plastic decking.

Shortner Park: No immediate concerns were noted.

Scotch Creek Park: No immediate concerns were noted.

Ball Park Complex: Van Ert will be replacing the panel, which will correct the outfield lights. JK Excavating will be working on the drainage issue on the northwest side of the park. A concrete pad will be installed below the stairs, which will connect to the asphalt.

A new playground from Swing Kingdom (the same company that created the last purchased playset) was designed for the area at the Ball Park Complex. The committee reviewed it and decided to bring it back this fall for consideration.

Scotch Creek Preserve: The Edgar Area Trail System is continuing to research possibly placing a 16' x 30' storage building along the trail system to house the two sleds and the Ranger. Several ideas were discussed with a possible solution being an addition/new building at the ballpark complex to replace the blue shed. A partition could be installed in the shed and could be utilized by both EATS and the various groups that use the fields. Rick Mueller will work on a CAD design and will share that with the groups involved. It would be a future project, as the goal would be for all organizations that utilize it to share in the costs.

Adjournment: Motion by Schueller/Denfeld to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:03 p.m.
